KIDZONE will dismiss after the music offering. Please gather your children from the Children's Suite downstairs immediately after the service.

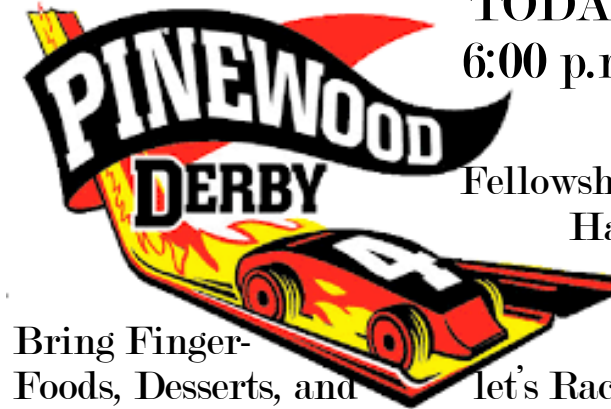
